We warmly invite you to experience the heritage, hospitality, and healing spirit of Odisha as we come together for this enriching academic gathering.

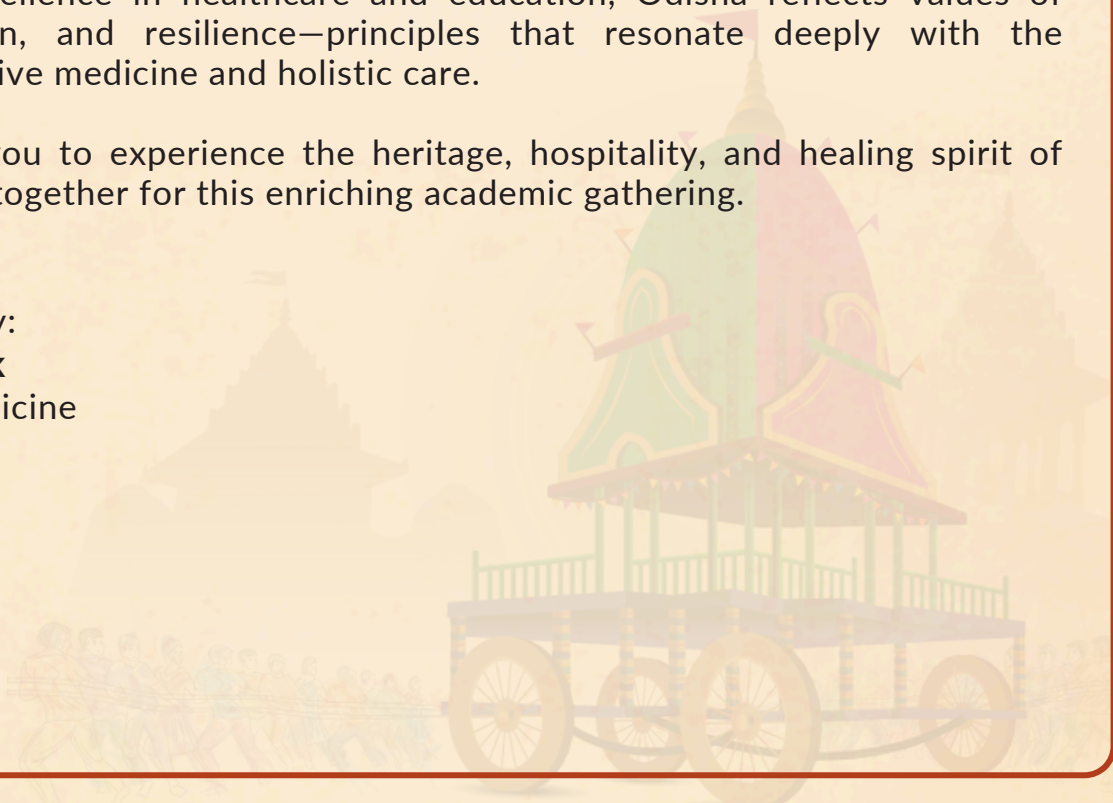
